LAUNCH OF THE MC3-JATC ADVISORY COMMITTEE

As the non-profit partner of the Alameda, Contra Costa, and Napa-Solano Building Trades Councils, CTWI's mission is to build workforce partnerships that increase union market share and create direct pathways into the union construction trades for nontraditional populations.

This year, CTWI established an MC3-JATC advisory committee to assess and provide feedback for local Multi-Craft Core Curriculum (MC3) pre-apprenticeship programs. The committee consists of JATC training coordinators and other trade reps from 12 apprenticeship programs representing both list and hunt trades.



CTWI has been working with apprenticeship programs to

- **Enhance** the quality of MC3 pre-apprenticeship programs
- **Strengthen** relationships between MC3 and union apprenticeship programs
- **Promote & Adopt** JATC standards that create pathways for MC3 graduates into an apprenticeship

Since the launch in January, committee members have been visiting MC3 programs to network with the participants, observe instruction in action, and develop recommendations for best practices in training math, job readiness, green construction, and hands-on construction.

Reps from Sprinkler Fitters UA 483, Operating Engineers OE 3, Elevator Constructors IUEC 8, and Sheet Metal Workers SMW 104 each gave a presentation and Q&A. Attendees included MC3 students and alumni, adult school construction test prep students, and other job seekers and educators.

Congratulations to the MC3 graduates from RichmondBUILD, Cypress Mandela and Rising Sun! Future Build will be holding their next graduation on May 25th. The students attended a 10 to 16 week training, which includes hands-on construction, industryrelevant safety certificates like OSHA 10 and HAZWOPER 40, and other career readiness skills like financial literacy. All graduates earn a nationally recognized MC3 certificate. We are so proud of our graduates and their hard work and dedication!



RichmondBUILD graduate Jen D. was indentured into the Painters and Tapers Union.

We also celebrate our graduates who have been placed in union apprenticeship programs. In the past 6 months, 37 MC3 graduates have become construction union apprentices or employees for signatory contractors! Our MC3 graduates have joined the carpenters, electrical workers, operating engineers, and many more trades. Since September 2020, our 4 partner MC3 programs have achieved a 96% general placement (employment) rate and 58% apprenticeship placement rate, of graduates to date.
